Event Report – 16th December, 2018 (7:30am to 2pm)

Breeze Charitable Trust organized a donation drive for the kids at Pasaydan Balbhavan, Khadavli on 16th December, 2018. The donation that was collected from various sources, was organized and packed by the members and wrapped as gifts. Each gift packet included writing materials, drawing materials, books, etc. that would help students in their education.

The team left for the orphanage at 7:30am and reached the venue by 9:30am. The kids welcomed the team by a short prayer and a welcome song that Mr. Baban Shinde, the caretaker-cum-owner of the organization, had taught them. The kids were aged 3-10. The team spent more than an hour with the kids, asking them to introduce themselves, to dance, to sing. It was a jolly moment and there were smiles all around. It was amazing to see the confidence in the kids when they showcased their talents. Soon after, gifts were distributed to the kids. The kids were mesmerized and were eager to open what Team Breeze had brought for them. The smiles were truly a sense of satisfaction for the team.

Soon after, Mr. Shubham Panda briefed Mr. Baban and some of the other members of Pasaydan Balbhavan about the existence of Breeze, how it works and how it plans to work in the future. This was followed by a 30-minute talk by Mr. Baban where he explained the existence and workflow of Pasaydan Balbhavan, its achievements and so on. Both, Breeze Charitable Trust and Pasaydan Balbhavan, bid farewell to each other with a promise that they'll collaborate in the future and work together for the welfare of these kids.

Next, the team headed towards Holy Cross, Kalyan, an orphanage only for females. The environment was very calm. Being, a female-only orphanage, it was good to see that proper checks were made before any person or team was allowed to meet the kids. The team had already confirmed the dates with the caretaker and were allowed-in to distribute gifts to the kids. The kids here were aged 5-17. In the short span of time, the kids introduced themselves so did Mr. Shubham Panda on behalf of the team. The team exchanged smiles and signed off by 2pm.
